Five Things Every Handgun Owner Should Know

1. The Range Can't Fully Prepare You for Real-World Shootings

Practicing at a target range is an important activity for any defensive shooter. Stance, sight alignment, breath control and trigger control are all critical components of accurate shooting. Practicing these will always be important. Spend time at the range, and lots of it, but be aware that the time you spend on the range does not fully prepare you for real-world defensive shootings.

In a defensive shooting scenario, everything changes. You're not at the range anymore. You are defending your life or the life of another. Your heart is pounding up through your throat. Your subject is cloaked in darkness. You are fixated on your threat and your sights are an afterthought. You have almost no time to respond.

This is not wild speculation. That's what it is really like. These are facts borne out by statistics from the National Institute of Justice (NIJ), which is the research and development agency of the U.S.

Department of Justice. Dedicated to researching crime and justice issues, the NIJ has compiled data on Law Enforcement shootings in the United States. The numbers will shock you.

According to NIJ figures, more than 80% of shootings happen in low or reduced light. Even with night sights, darkness makes accurate shooting using traditional methods very challenging.

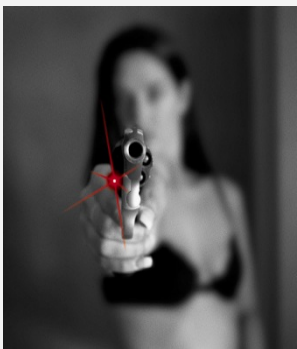

It is a fact that most defensive shootings occur at very close range. The attacker is usually within seven yards! Split second decisions have life and death consequences. In most cases, there is no time for a traditional sight picture, let alone your range-perfected shooting stance.

Even if you manage such a response, you could be putting your gun within reach of the attacker, who might disarm you.

Another big difference between the practice range and the real world is movement. How often have you practiced shooting while moving or shooting at moving targets? According to the NIJ, most shootings involve movement of either the shooter or the target. Maintaining alignment with traditional sights in this situation is difficult at best.

Thanks to Lasergrrips, you now have access to a tool that can help you overcome challenges such as darkness, close range, time and movement. It's all about giving yourself the tools for surviving an encounter with real-world bad guys who are trying to kill you.

The idea is simple: Project a dot onto the threat/target. As Robert Hausman of High Tech Firearms magazine describes it: "... (a laser-equipped handgun) allows true point-shooting capability. The gun need only be drawn, the dot placed on the intended point of impact, and the trigger pressed."

2. Trauma of Attack Causes Uncontrollable Physiological Changes

When you're attacked, or you draw your gun to prevent violence, powerful changes rampage through your mind and body. A powerful adrenaline rush (the "Fight-or-flight" response) kicks in, and you cannot stop it. Your muscles tense, vision narrows. These changes prepare you for physical battle or a swift move to cover. Yet these same changes limit your ability to shoot accurately.

The most dramatic change is the loss of fine motor skill. Your physiological reactions prepare your body to use torso to fight or escape. Fine motor skill is sacrificed – it is not required for "Fight-or-Flight". But fine motor skills **are necessary** to operate a handgun effectively and efficiently. Operating a handgun without fine motor skills is a struggle: you struggle to hold the gun steady, struggle to pull the trigger smoothly, and struggle to line up sights accurately.

Sighting with lasergrrips is far more accurate during movement because it is only necessary to keep the red dot on target. During high stress confrontations, the laser provides an accurate indicator of muzzle orientation at all times. More importantly, firing accuracy is more reliable than using muscle memory alone. This is particularly true if your posture is strained or awkward, or if you've been wounded.

As we've mentioned, range time is important. Lasergrrips can increase the depth and intensity of your training. With Lasergrrips effective dry-fire practice of advanced tactics will help shooters of all skill levels. These techniques, such as shooting on the move and from awkward positions, are vital to surviving an armed encounter. In talking about training, Massad Ayoob, world-renowned firearms instructor and self-defense expert writes: "I carry a lasergripped Model 442 as a backup gun and teaching tool when instructing. The laser comes into its own in training. It lets an instructor graphically demonstrate why jerking the trigger will send the shot awry."

You need to be aware of the physiological effects which a lethal attack will have on you.

- Target Fixation/Focus
- Limited Near vision acuity
- Narrowed field of vision
- Auditory Exclusion
- "Spray & Pray" reflex
- Sympathetic Nervous System Reaction

Most people involved in shootings report never seeing their sights, and it's no mystery why. Our natural reaction, when faced with a threat is to focus on the threat. This "Target Fixation/Focus" is in keeping with our responsibility to first verify, and then deal with, a dangerous scenario.



How do you focus on the threat AND your sights at the same time? The traditional answer is: you can't. Enter the 21st Century. With reliable, state-of-the-art technology you simply move your sights onto the target by projecting a laser dot. You will need a reliable laser sight like lasergrrips. One that is accurate, durable and dependable. It must be simple to install and intuitive in operation.

Todd Jarrett, World champion shooter and international military/LE trainer, states: "As a person who knows what the front sight looks like, in a CQB (Close Quarter Battle) environment, you never see your front sight. Why not superimpose a laser on your threat? I'm 50% faster coming out on target and can outrun my tritium sights by at least 20% in speed and accuracy with Lasergrrips."

3. Agencies Improve Their Hit Ratio by Over 300% with Lasergrrips

U.S. law enforcement officers are some of the best trained shooters in the world, but hit ratios from shootings in the field are staggeringly low. The latest NIJ data shows that police officers using traditional sighting and training methods hit their mark only about 25% of the time when shots are fired. Remember: These are trained professionals. Men and women who must qualify on the range with high scores in order to keep their jobs.

Missed shots pose big problems. First and foremost, a miss means that the gunfight is still on, so the situation remains dangerous. The second problem is that as a gun owner, you are accountable for every bullet you fire. Bullets that miss the mark must land somewhere. A stray bullet that hits an innocent bystander is your responsibility. So why are hit ratios so low?

- (1) Over 80% of shootings occur at night, which makes aiming difficult.
- (2) Most armed encounters involve movement of the officer and/or the subject. Again, hindering aim.
- (3) Add the stresses of a life or death situation, and it's easy to see why so many rounds miss their mark.

When it comes to accuracy under high stress, Lasergrrips give you an immediate and decisive advantage that no other handgun accessory can equal. Improving your ability to aim under low-light and stressful situations will help you survive an armed encounter.

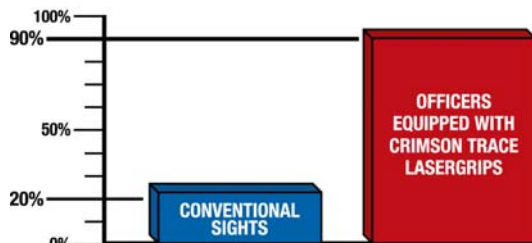
